# **ChecksumHelper** · Overview

- When **ChecksumHelper** is referred to in the following, it means the entire package. The package consists of the app and the manuals (German and English in LoRes and HiRes) in a sub folder.
- ChecksumHelper.app gives the user the ability to calculate or check the checksums of a selected file.
- ChecksumHelper.app is a "wrapper" for the corresponding shell scripts.
- The following checksums are currently supported:
  - SHA1
  - SHA256
  - MD5
  - cksum
  - CRC32.
- Additional checksums can be added as required. Just contact me.

#### Notes:

- ➡ I've tried to make ChecksumHelper.app as "safe" (in the meaning of operation errors) as possible.
- The default buttons have been selected so that the most likely "route" can be used directly by pressing the [Return/Enter] key.
- In the **second** dialog box of **ChecksumHelper**.app, the concrete version number is displayed in the boxes' title.
- → Dialog boxes within an AppleScript always open at center screen. Unfortunately, I have no influence on this.

# ChecksumHelper.app · Manual

ChecksumHelper.app gets started by double-clicking.


#### 1. dialog box · Selecting the file

The first dialog box is used to select the file to be handled.

The dialog box that appears, is the default selection box of the macOS.

After selecting a file with the [Select] button, a check is made whether ChecksumHelper.app can calculate the checksum of the selected file.


If e.g. an application is selected, this error message appears.



For clarity, the name of the selected file is displayed at the beginning of each dialog box.

#### • 2. dialog box • Entering a checksum / Starting the calculations


In the second dialog box, a checksum can be entered for checking and / or the actual process of calculating the checksum of the selected file can be triggered by selecting the [Check.] button.



With the [No, quit.] button, ChecksumHelper.app can immediately be terminated without any further actions.

#### 3. dialog box • Displaying the results

If **no** checksum has been entered in the second dialog box, the **calculated** checksums are displayed here.



If one of the checksums are needed for further reference, it can be selected by a double-click and copied to the clipboard via [% + C].


By selecting the [Copy to clipboard.] button, you can also copy the entire list of results to the clipboard. Immediately after this, ChecksumHelper.app is terminated.

With the [Thanks.] button, ChecksumHelper.app can be terminated without further actions.

#### 4. dialog box · Verification of a checksum


If a checksum has been entered in the second dialog box, the results are displayed here.

• If the checksums match, this dialog box appears:



In addition, the calculated checksum and its algorithm are displayed.

• If the checksums do **not** match, the following dialog box appears:



Additionally, the **entered** and **all calculated** checksums are displayed.

By selecting the [Copy to clipboard.] button, you can also copy the entire list of results to the clipboard. Immediately after this, ChecksumHelper.app is terminated.

With the [Thanks.] button, ChecksumHelper.app can be terminated without further actions.

#### **Additional Notes**

#### Minimum requirements

for **ChecksumHelper** are AppleScript v.2.4 resp. macOS from v.10.10.x. Therefore, for all macOS versions before v.10.10.x: no support!

#### GateKeeper

- Depending on the GateKeeper setting, the installed app has to be started once by double-clicking or ^-clicking + "Open" by an administrator so that non-administrator users can use the app without the hassle of macOS requests because GateKeeper may otherwise block this app, The app does not have to run through completely, but can be terminated immediately after the start:
  - ChecksumHelper.app: press [ESC].
- Apple decided to hide the option [Anywhere] in macOS v.10.12.x Sierra in GateKeeper settings in [System Preferences<Security<General<Allow apps downloaded from:]. This also affects ChecksumHelper.app because I am not a certified developer. As a result, the error message "ChecksumHelper.app is damaged and can not be opened. It is recommended to move the object to the Trash." (or something similar) is displayed. Unfortunately, no ^-click + "open" can help under these circumstances.</li>
- Instead, the following approach helps:
  - start **Terminal**.app, type [sudo spctl --master-disable] (without the square brackets!) and enter the administrator password.
  - then select in the aforementioned **System Preferences** the option [**Anywhere**].
  - confirm the security demand.
  - start ChecksumHelper.app.
  - then in the aforementioned **System Preferences** the option [**Anywhere**] can be deselected.
  - according to the Security demand, the option [Anywhere] disappears again automatically from the System Preferences after 30 days,.
  - if you need the option [Anywhere] to disappear earlier:
    - start **Terminal**.app, type [sudo spctl --master-enable] (without the square brackets!) and enter the administrator password.

### Installation

The **installation** of the **ChecksumHelper** package works as follows:

- log-in as an Administrator:
- double-clicking on the downloaded installation package opens a new window of the installation volume.
- I recommend to copy the **included** directory < ChecksumHelper/> to < Macintosh HD/Programs/Utilities/>.
- The administrator password is requested during the copying process.
- After the installation completed, the installation volume can be ejected.
- Please regard the notes on **GateKeeper** in the "**Additional Notes**" section!
